Guernsey Advisory Circulars (GACs) are issued to provide advice, guidance and information on standards, practices, and procedures necessary to facilitate the application and processing of applications for services related to the Guernsey Aircraft Register.

They are not in themselves law or a regulation but may amplify provisions of the laws and regulations, including the Guernsey Aviation Requirements (GARs), or provide practical guidance. Since GAC's are non-binding, regulated persons may choose alternative means to comply with the guidance. In this case, however, they lose the presumption of compliance provided by the circular and need to demonstrate to the Office of the Director Civil Aviation (ODCA), or Office of the Aircraft Registrar (OAR) as applicable, that they do comply with the law.

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1 - Purpose

The purpose of this Guernsey Advisory Circular is to make public the opening hours and contact details for inspecting the registers maintained by 2-REG on behalf of the Aircraft Registrar.

2 - Related laws and regulations

This Guernsey Advisory Circular relates to:

- 2.1 The Aviation Registry (Guernsey) Law, 2013, sections 10(1) and 10(6); and
- 2.2 The Aviation Registry (Fees) Regulations, 2018.

3 - Definitions

Definitions, in the context of this GAC shall have the meanings listed in GAR Part 1 (Definitions, Abbreviations and Units of Measurement).

4 - The Registers

The following registers are available for inspection by the public:

- The Aircraft Register;
- The Engine Register;
- The Charges Register.

5 - Days and hours for public inspection

The registers maintained pursuant to section 10(1) of the law referred to in section 2.1 above are open for public inspection during normal weekdays from 10:00 to 16:00 hours. By prior telephone arrangements, another time for inspection may be arranged.

7 - Location

Upon request, copies or extracts of entries in the Registers will be supplied certified or uncertified.
